

Life Cycle of a Flower

Paper Plate Activity

Thanks for downloading our monthly freebie! Print these templates and have fun creating a spinning life cycle of a flower.



Materials:

Two 9 inch paper plates

Scissors

Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencils

Glue

Brad (Paper Fastener)

Directions: Print out each circle template.

Front Plate: Cut out the circle. Color and glue to the center of the front plate (the 1st of the two plates).

Cut along the cut lines on the front plate template, cutting out the triangle or “pie slice” of both the paper and the plate.

Back Plate: Color each part of the life cycle. Cut out each individual triangle or “slice” and glue them in the correct order of the life cycle on the back plate (the 2nd of the two plates). Cut and glue labels on each correct triangle.

Correct answers are at the end of this document.

Assembly: Stack the two plates on top of each other. Carefully using scissors, poke a hole in the center of the two plates. Place the brad in the hole and you should be able to rotate your life cycle!

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


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
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Front Plate Template
